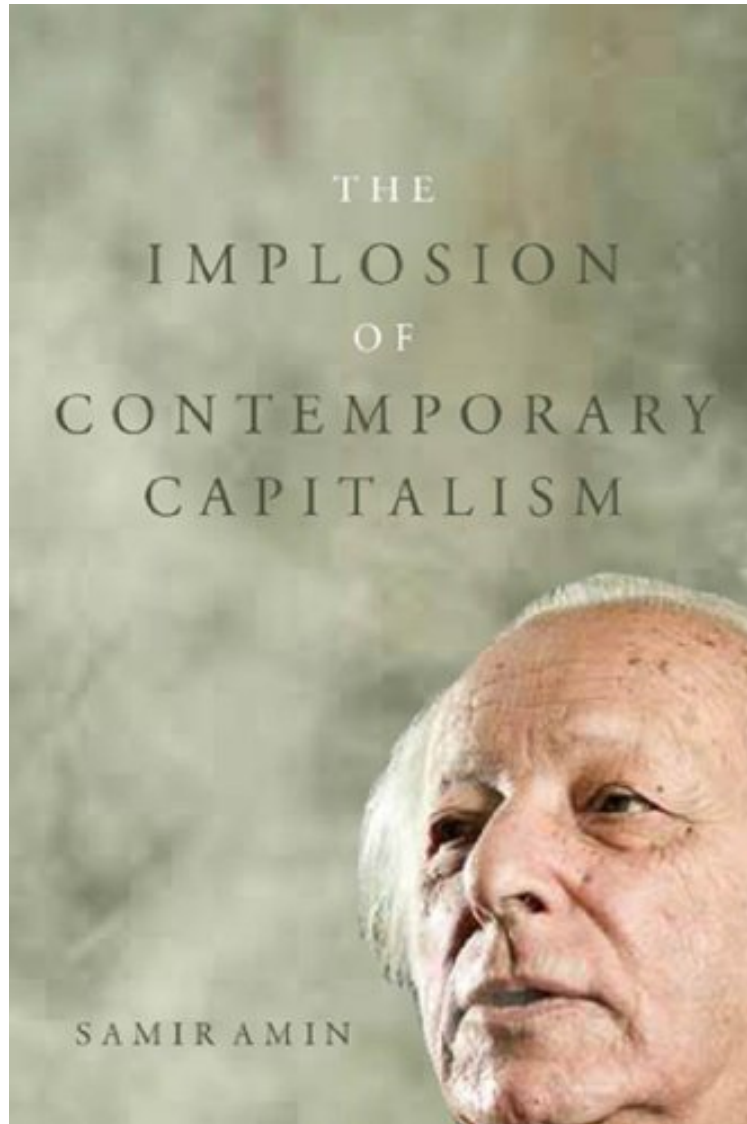

Amin's greatest strength is his ability to covers such a large swatch of issues in a succinct and theoretically informed manner. His conceptualization of our current era as "generalized monopoly capitalism" is

compelling and helps update Baran and Sweezy's original conceptualization of Monopoly Capitalism. This would be a great book for college courses, both advanced undergrad and graduate.
