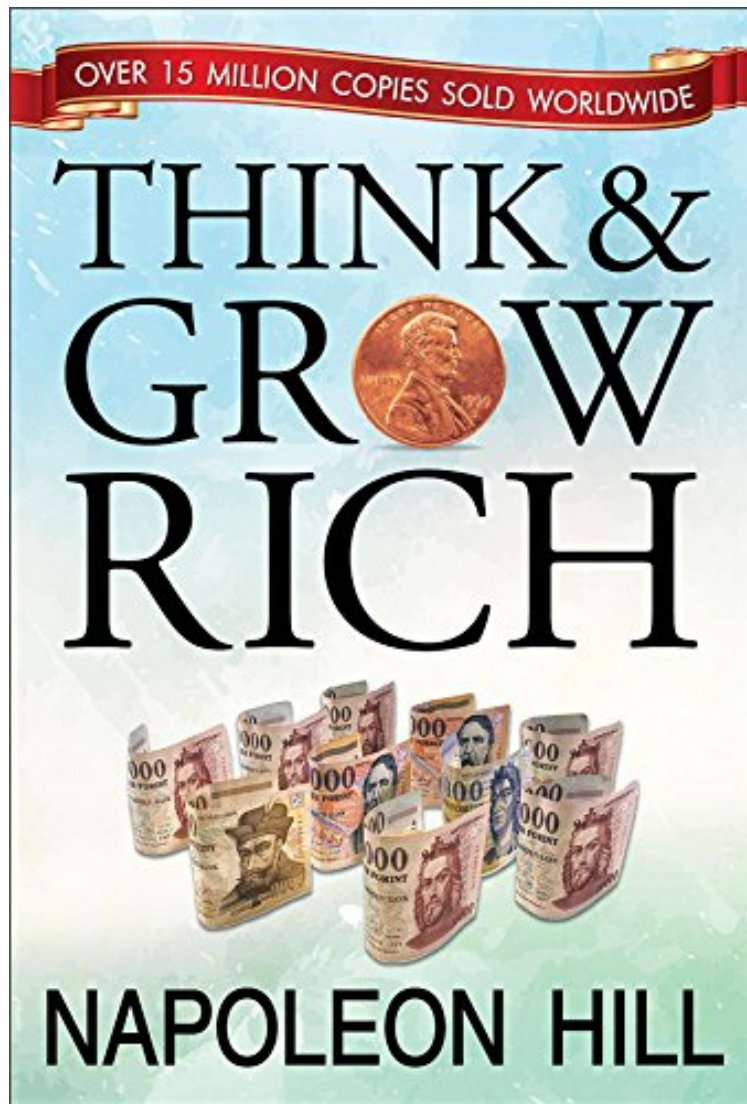

The version I purchased (black cover with money on the bottom, kindle version) is riddled with errors where the publisher evidently SCANNED the book in and then didn't bother to edit the results. Page numbers appear randomly in the middle of paragraphs, "m" appears where clearly "in" was intended and in some cases paragraphs just end in the middle of a sentence. This is a great book but some of the publishers have done a terrible job reproducing it and isn't

helping by grouping very different copies together in the same review group. I hope to update this review when I find a less crappy copy of this book, but avoid the version with the black cover with money on the bottom.
