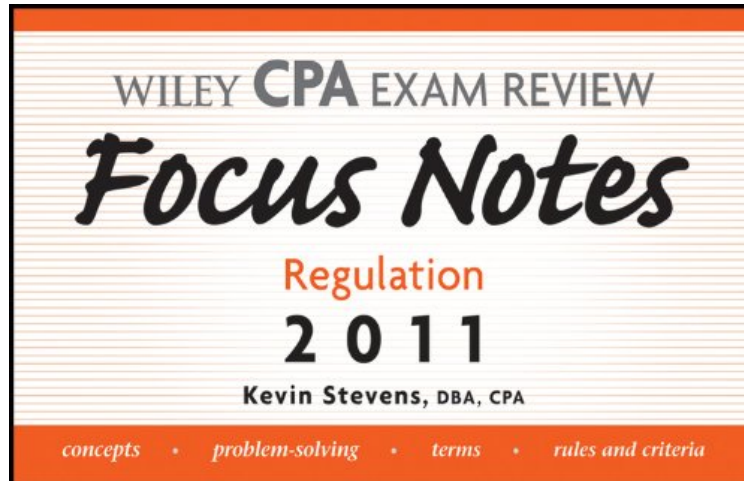

I'm not using Wiley as my main study package so there are slight differences but if you understand the overall content it's fine. The reason for 4 Stars is that the book consistently has errors regarding the Supply and Demand graphs (showing a negative slope for S curve). It's not a major problem but irritating nonetheless. It's ok, but there were several typos and lack of coverage. By Jessica Lafave This product is ok to give you a quick refresher, but you had better have a strong background going into it. I thought there was lack of coverage on some very important topics, like business structure. It also had several typos and some information that was just plain wrong. For example, the picture of the supply curve is actually the demand curve again. I'm not sure they were really worth the money.

This book uses acronyms and mnemonic devices to help candidates remember the accounting rules and checklists needed to pass the exam. It provides a thorough review of all basic skills and concepts need for the exam. The new computerized CPA exam includes one or two case study simulations in each section, approximately 20-40 minutes in length, that will require candidates to perform research activities, use common spreadsheet and word processing functions, and use a financial calculator or spreadsheet to perform financial calculations. In order to assist candidates

in successfully performing these simulations, Wiley Focus Notes include references to authoritative literature, sample spreadsheets, and key concepts, tips and tools to facilitate research
