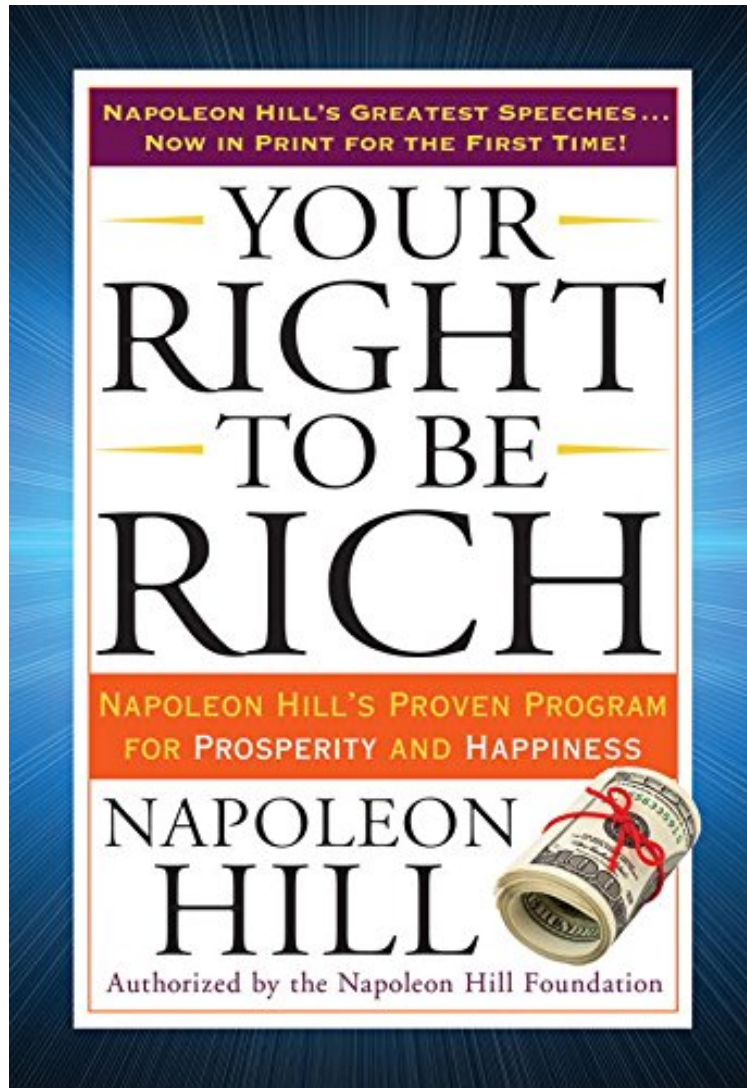

This is a different lecture series and doesn't translate directly to the book. It has seventeen components instead of the thirteen principles, and most of the material is reorganized. This is not a substitute for the book. What I did like about this is the ability to get to know the author. Hill's personality shines throughout this lecture from the 1950's. It's a magnificent view into the man who wrote Think and Grow Rich.
